ESSENTIALITY CERTIFICATE

This is to certify that there is presently a need to start the B.Sc.(Nursing) College. At present, there are 11 Nursing Colleges in the State of Maharashtra and have 440 admission seats in all B.Sc. Nursing colleges. The ratio of the B.Sc. Nurses to the population of Maharashtra is 1:575743. At present there are 10 B.Sc. Nursing Colleges having only 390 admission capacity in the Rest of Maharashtra region. Hence, it is desirable to grant permission to start a new B.Sc. Nursing College with annual intake capacity of 30 students at "**Barshi, Dist.Solapur by Shri Shivaji Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, Shivaji Nagar,Barshi, Dist. Solapur**" in State of Maharashtra.

2. This certificate is being given on the condition that, "**Shri Shivaji Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, Shivaji Nagar,Barshi, Dist. Solapur, Maharashtra**" will fulfil the norms and conditions laid down by the Nursing Council of India, New Delhi and the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and will not employ / engage any teacher from the Government Nursing College except on their retirement at superannuation.
